CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT PETER A. SPEEN

Chief Master Sergeant Peter A. Speen is the Command Chief Master Sergeant of the 71st Flying Training Wing, Vance Air Force Base, Oklahoma. He advises the commander on the mission effectiveness, professional development, military readiness, training, utilization, health, morale, and welfare for 2,500 total force personnel executing 297,000 annual aircraft operations. Chief Speen provides leadership to the 500 Airmen enlisted force and is the functional manager for the wing's group superintendents and first sergeants, enabling the wing's specialized undergraduate pilot training mission and the deliberate development of the wing's Airmen.

Chief Speen grew up in Auburn, New York. He entered the Air Force in 1987. His background is in the Security Forces, Enlisted Aide, and Manpower career fields. Chief Speen served in fighter wings, training wings, expeditionary wings, and Headquarters positions at the 19th Air Force, the Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe, the North Atlantic Treaty Organization, the Air Force Special Operations Command, the Air Force Manpower Agency, and the Headquarters United States Air Force, Pentagon. His assignments include bases in Virginia, Texas, Florida, New Jersey, Mississippi, Europe, and Korea. He assumed his current duties at Vance AFB in June 2014.
