SUBJECT: 45 Day No Heat / No Cool Period

1. In response to energy reduction goals for FY09, Vance AFB facilities will enter a no heat / no cool period from 6 April to 20 May 2009. Due to special uses and/or mission requirements, certain facilities are to exceed the standard to a maximum heating temperature of 72 degrees and a maximum cooling standard of 78 degrees. Those designated facilities are:

B-323 Youth Center
B-336 Child Development Center (CDC)
B-713 and B-714 Cherokee Lodge
B-790 Temporary Living Facility (TLF)

2. If the outside air temperature drops below 45 degrees, facilities may be heated to winter standard. If the outside air temperature rises above 90 degrees, facilities may be cooled to an 80 degree standard. Between 45 degree and 90 degree outside air temperature control the effects of humidity by adjusting the volume of air flow and outside air to make indoor climates as tolerable as possible.

3. This policy letter will remain in effect through September 2009 and applies to all personnel assigned to or residing on Vance AFB. Please direct any questions regarding this policy to CSC/CEEE at 213-7154.
