1. During the background investigation, information was found that determines your presence is detrimental to the maintenance of good order and discipline at Vance AFB. This is in accordance with Vance AFB Base Defense Plan.
2. You may appeal this decision using the pre-established appeal procedures identified below. A copy of this letter must be included with the appeal request. Your appeal package will be reviewed by the 71st Security Forces Squadron, Defense Force Commander (71 SFS/CC) and a final determination will be made by the 71st Flying Training Wing Commander.
3. The appeal request must be submitted in writing (typed or hand-written) to 71 SFS/S5R, 318 S. Brown Road, Vance AFB, OK 73705 or emailed to 71sfs.vcc@us.af.mil.
4. Appeal packages may include information related to your circumstance, to include court documents showing reduced sentencing, personal statements, police reports, conviction paperwork, and certificates of rehabilitation, if appropriate. You may also submit any character references or letters of recommendation from your current or previous employers.
