Tax tip – Those who sign up for electronic delivery of their bank statements should expect that their tax Form 1099-INT indicating their interest earned is delivered electronically as well. Don't forget to look for this form when filing taxes. Those who earn over \$10 in interest each year will have one. The IRS expects all annual interest amounts over 50 cents to be reported, and this is generally annotated as a year-to-date interest paid on your December statement.
