### What is Sexual Assault?

Sexual Assault is a crime. It is defined as intentional sexual contact, characterized by use of force, physical threat or abuse of authority or when the victim does not or cannot consent. Sexual assault can occur without regard to gender or spousal relationship or age of victim. Sexual assault includes:

- Rape
- Sexual Assault
- Aggravated / Abusive Sexual Contact
- Nonconsensual sodomy (oral or anal sex)
- Indecent assault (unwanted, inappropriate sexual contact or fondling) or attempts to commit these acts.

### If You Experience a Sexual Assault

- Try to get to a safe and secure location away from the perpetrator.
- If possible, do not shower, bathe, change clothes, brush your teeth, eat or drink anything or clean up the area where you were sexually assaulted.
- If you are in an emergency situation or need immediate medical attention, call 911 or go to the nearest emergency room and request a sexual assault forensic exam (SAFE) **\*Be advised that disclosing a sexual assault to law enforcement compromises the restricted reporting option.**

### What is Sexual Harassment?

Sexual Harassment is a form of sex discrimination that involves unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, and other verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature when:

- Submission to such conduct is made either explicitly or implicitly a term or condition of an individual's employment, or (quid pro quo)
- Submission to or rejection of such conduct by an individual is used as a basis for career or employment decisions affecting such individual, or (quid pro quo)
- Such conduct has the purpose or effect of unreasonably interfering with an individual's work performance or creates an intimidating, hostile, or offensive environment; and is so severe or pervasive that a reasonable person would perceive, and the victim does perceive, the environment as hostile or offensive.

### If You Experience Sexual Harassment

- **DAF Service Members** may contact the Vance AFB SAPR Office at (580) 213-5598 to file a:

**Restricted Report** – This reporting option allows a Service member to confidentially report sexual harassment and receive victim advocacy services from that office. This reporting option does not trigger an investigation or notification to the Service member's command or installation EO office, unless there is written consent from the Service member or, if there is a clear and present risk to health and safety to the Service member or another person, as determined in consultation with the servicing legal office.

**Unrestricted Report** – This reporting option allows a Service member to report sexual harassment and receive victim advocacy services from that office. This reporting option will result in the SARC or SAPR VA notifying and conducting an in-person, virtual, or telephonic referral with installation equal opportunity (EO) office to initiate an investigation (or clarification report via EO processes) of the sexual harassment allegation(s).

\*Note: This victim advocacy option does not replace the military equal opportunity complaints process as described in DAF Instruction 36-2710, Equal Opportunity Program. As such, military members electing an Unrestricted report with the SAPR office to receive sexual harassment victim advocacy may also choose to file a separate Military Equal Opportunity (MEO) complaint alleging sexual harassment through the EO office or can go directly to their commander to report the allegation.

**DAF Civilians, Service member dependents, and retirees** may be eligible to use the Equal Opportunity (EO) complaint process to address allegations of sexual harassment.

The CATCH Program gives people making a sexual assault report where the name of the suspect is not known by law enforcement an opportunity to anonymously submit suspect information to help the Department of Defense identify serial offenders.
